Dear Ms Skinner.

Thank you for your letter of 12 March 2024 to the Commissioner for Health and Food Safety, Stella Kyriakides, on the topic of the Commission proposal for a Council Recommendation on vaccine-preventable cancers (1) that was published on 31 January this year. Thank you also for your contribution (2) to the Call for Evidence that was part of the robust consultation procedure that informed the proposal, allowing all stakeholders to share their views.

The Council Recommendation on vaccine-preventable cancers (3) is now adopted, and as you will see, it contains a large number of recommendations that will help Member States reduce the cancer burden linked to infection with Human papillomaviruses and Hepatitis B through increased uptake of vaccination. As some head-and-neck cancers are caused by Human papillomaviruses, the new Council Recommendation may also help reduce the number of cases of such cancers.
